


Daily Reported New Positive COVID-19 Tests vs. Daily Reported Deaths from COVID-19 in the U.S.



As of October 14, 2020



Total Deaths and COVID-19 Deaths in the U.S. by Age Group


February 1, 2020 - October 10, 2020

March 25, 2020 - October 12, 2020





San Francisco is on pace to suffer from more than 675 overdose deaths in 2020, a 53% increase from 2019's total of 441.2 That would represent 234 additional overdose deaths, or nearly double the 123 COVID-19 related deaths in the city so far this year.3
